



Seeding Success Consent Form  
Request for Release of Student Records

Seeding Success requests access to information connected to a student's identity, including a student's grades, test scores, progress reports, attendance records, discipline records, student ID number, and registration and enrollment records. Seeding Success may share student records, information, or data with education partners that can provide Seeding Success direct support in delivering education support services to Shelby County Schools. The purpose for accessing or sharing education records, information, or data related to your student is to better provide education support services throughout his/her academic career. No records, information, or data will be used for any other purpose.

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) protects students and parents by prohibiting most third parties from accessing student records, information, or data without written permission from a parent or guardian if the student is under 18.

By checking the box below, I am indicating that I give Shelby County Schools permission to share my student's education records, information, or data about my student to Seeding Success. I am also indicating that I give Seeding Success permission to share my student's education records, information, and data about my student to other approved partners (**see below for a full list of partners**). I understand I have a right to inspect any written records released pursuant to this consent. I further understand I may revoke this consent upon providing to Shelby County Schools written notice of my decision to revoke this consent. I further understand that until this revocation is made, this consent shall remain in effect and my student's educational records, information, or data will continue to be provided for the specific purposes described above.
